



Wings Family Code of Conduct

Expectation of all session participants

We strive every day to build character with the participants in the session

We have the following expectations of them to make that possible.

They will:

- Show respect for others: Our members will respect the rights and feelings of the other participants. Fighting, bullying, name calling, intimidations, bigotry of any kind, inappropriate language or any other form of emotional or physical abuse or unwanted contact directed to one another, management staff or volunteers will not be tolerated. Any member of Wings who appears to be bullying will be asked to leave the group immediately. Session leaders are staff in development. They will be given the same respect as a member of staff, and so will volunteers.
- Maintain a Professional Focus: Our students are expected to pay attention to and follow the management and staff so that they can get the most out of their time here. Disruptive, distracting or problematic behaviour that affects this learning environment will not be tolerated. Members may not use mobile phones or electronic games during sessions, rehearsals, or performances unless permission has been granted. Mobile phones must remain off during these periods.
- Respect our Building: All will respect the buildings facilities and equipment regardless of location. Members are expected to tidy up after themselves and work to keep the building clean.
- Always Arrive On Time: Show up to sessions, rehearsals and performances on-time (unless agreed with staff) and ready to get to work with all necessary items. For example props, costumes, notes or scripts etc.
- Dress Appropriately: Our session members are expected to dress appropriately with the correct footwear for all sessions, according to the dress code (**see policies & procedures**) unless instructed by a member of staff.
- Make the most of their sessions: We will allocate one toilet break per session, which will be supervised by a staff member will be DBS checked. However we do ask the children to use the toilet before and after sessions.
- Not eating during sessions: Members are required to bring a drink, eating during the session is not permitted unless previously agreed. This includes chewing gum.
